## DRAFT WINE RETAILER SHIPPING LEGISLATION

(Create a new section of the state's alcohol beverage code as follows)

## SECTION (Section number or title)

- Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to the contrary, any person currently licensed in this or any other state as a wine retailer and who obtains a Wine Retailer Shipping Permit, as provided below, may ship up to eighteen nine-liter cases of wine annually to a resident of [State] who is at least 21 years of age for personal use only and not for resale.
- 2. To obtain a [State] Wine Retailer Shipping Permit, a wine retailer located out-of-state must first:
  - A) File an application with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control.
  - B) Pay a \$100.00 registration fee.
  - C) Submit to the Department of Alcohol Beverage Control a copy of its current alcoholic beverage license issued in its home state.
- 3. The holder of a [State] Wine Retailer Shipping Permit shall:
  - A) Not ship more than eighteen 9-liter cases of wine annually to any person in [State]
  - B) Not ship to any address in [State] in an area identified by the Department of Alcohol Beverage Control as a "dry" or local option area.
  - C) Label the outside of all shipping boxes of wine shipped directly to a resident in [State] as follows "CONTAINS ALCOHOL: SIGNATURE OF PERSON AGE 21 OR OLDER REQUIRED FOR DELIVERY."
  - D) Report to the Department of Alcohol Beverage Control annually the total amount of wine shipped into [State] during the preceding calendar year.
  - E) Annually pay to the [State] Revenue Agency all applicable sales taxes due on sales of wine to residents of [State] during the preceding calendar year.
  - F) Allow the Department of Alcohol Beverage Control or any other state agency to perform an audit of Wine Retail Shipping permit holder's shipping records.

- G) Agree to have consented to the jurisdiction of the Department of Alcohol Beverage Control or any other state agency and to the [State] courts concerning enforcement of this section and any related laws, rules or regulations.
- H) Receive at the time of delivery of shipments of wine the signature of a person with a valid identification showing they are 21 years of age or older.
- 4. The Wine Retailer Shipping Permit holders may annually renew its permit with the Department of Alcohol Beverage Control by paying a \$100.00 renewal fee and providing the Department of Alcohol Beverage Control a copy of its current alcoholic beverage license issued in its home state.
- 5. The Department of Alcohol Beverage Control and the [State] Revenue Agency may promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate the purposes of this law.
